Service exploring how fast-fashion brands can encourage early returns to reduce waste and emissions.

- Planned and conducted user research by creating a survey answered by 200 respondents, interviewing 30+ shoppers, logistics experts and expert interviews with former heads of sustainability at H&M, ASOS, and Marks & Spencer to investigate returns behaviour in the fast fashion industry.
- Synthesised all the qualitative and quantitative data into user personas and multiple user journey maps to highlight gaps and user pain points in the current returns journey.
- Conducted co-creation sessions with 8 users and multiple service tests to refine concepts, ensuring usability and grounding the service in real world insights.
- Presented research findings and service concept at the 3-day RCA Design Expo (30k+ visitors) and received an offer from a startup incubator.
